

What is a WAG?

The Center for Pediatric Clinical Research and Development (CPCRD) is proud to sponsor a program to support our junior and mid-level researchers interested in pursuing National Institutes of Health K (Career Development) or R (Research) grants.

A <u>Writing Accountability Group</u>, or WAG, is moderated by someone who has successfully submitted a K or R grant. The group provides judgment-free accountability as submission tasks are outlined and monitored through frequent check-ins. The moderator and administrative staff will also provide grant writing educational materials, resources, and support.

WAGs are run based on the NIH grant submission cycles and typically begin about 5-6 months prior to the submission deadline.
